## RULES:

1. Read 4-H General Rules
2. Read 4-H Livestock, Equine & Small Animal Rules
3. Cats must have distemper and rabies shot prior to May 1, display a current tag, and upload copy of proof of immunization receipt from D.V.M. to 4HOnline by May 1
4. Exhibitor may supply own display cage or may use one provided.
5. Display cages should provide cats with litter box, litter and water. Additionally, a bottom liner such as a blanket or rug must be in place to provide traction for the cat.
6. No kittens under four months old will be allowed to show.
7. All cats must be on a halter and leash when outside of the cage.
8. Cats in heat are barred from showing. Cats may or may not be neutered/spayed.
9. Exhibitor must be on hand to show cat during judging.
10. Cat's toenails must be clipped before entry, front and back.
11. Interview judging is required of all exhibitors just before judging. Those not interviewed are not allowed to exhibit their animal for judging.
12. Exhibitor must complete a 4-H Record book interview and their book must be up-to-date to be eligible for exhibition. Please see Livestock, Horse and Small Animal Rules for more information.
13. To be a Colorado State Fair contestant in the Cat Show, the member must be a member in good standing and must have competed at the County Fair Cat Show.

## Record Book:

Cat members complete Companion Animal E-Record and any necessary supplements. Due the Friday before Labor Day



**Open Class:** Open Mini's (Age 5-7) Cat Class - See Department Open Minis Saturday, July 22nd 10:00am



**Cat Project members who intend to exhibit their animal(s) at the Adams County Fair must complete the following to remain eligible for fair entry and exhibition:**

1. Enroll in the Cats Project by the enrollment deadline
2. Complete and file an Animal Care and Housing Form on 4HOnline by deadline.
3. ID all animals and vaccination records in 4HOnline by May 1 deadline (project cat must be owned by ID deadline)
4. Attend Animal Record Book Interviews and present an up-to-date E-Record Book.
5. Enter fair classes online by deadline.
6. Your cat must meet the vaccination requirements to be eligible to enter in the County Fair.
7. Complete and turn in E-Record book the Friday following Labor Day to the Extension Office. *If a record book is not completed for each species exhibited, the member will forfeit premiums/awards and be ineligible to exhibit that species at the next year's Fair.*
