## RULES:

(also see Livestock, Equine & Small Animal Rules)

1. All cavies must have an ear tag that will be available at check in.
2. Exhibitor must supply their own cage/tub, water bottle, food bowl with food, and fresh vegetables/fruits.
3. Wood Shavings for bedding may be available unless exhibitor opts to bring own bedding.
4. No more than two cavies may be housed in the same cage/tub. The exception is in the 4-H Cavy Production Class.
5. All cavies must be brought to the judging table by the 4-H member or a designated representative. Cavies will be placed in the proper show cages according to ear tag on comment card. You may have a stand-in to exhibit your cavy only if you are involved in another 4-H function at the time of judging. Stand-in must be approved by the Superintendent.
6. Barn closes at 10:00pm each night and reopens at 5:45am
7. Sharing of project animals is not permitted.

## Record Book:

Complete and turn in the Companion Animal E-Record & supplement pages by the deadline.

**Cavy Project members who intend to exhibit their animal(s) at the Adams County Fair must complete the following to remain eligible for fair entry and exhibition:**

1. Enroll in the Cavy Project by the enrollment deadline.
2. Complete and file an Animal Care and Housing Form on 4HOnline by deadline.
3. ID all animals in 4HOnline by June 1 deadline (project cavy must be owned by ID deadline)
4. Attend Animal Record Book Interviews and present an up-to-date E-Record Book.
5. Enter fair classes online by deadline.
6. Members must complete and turn in (by deadline) a record book for each species in which they exhibit at Fair. *If a record book is not completed for each species exhibited, the member will forfeit premiums and be ineligible to exhibit that species at the next year's Fair.*



## 2023 SPECIAL SHOW MANAGEMENT: RHDV2 PRECAUTIONS

- Rabbit & Cavy Shows will be one day "Basket" Show due to precautions taken against the Rabbit Hemorrhagic Disease (RHDv2). Exhibitors should come prepared with prep tools & equipment in addition to housing, bedding, food & water for their animals to spend the day at fair.

The 2021-2025 American Rabbit Breeders Association Standard of Perfection will be used for judging all classes, and determining general faults and disqualifications.
