Deadline: July 7, 2023

Check-in: Cloverbud projects can be dropped off at the Dome Building on Monday, August 1st, 8:30am-noon. Clubs are responsible for setting up their Cloverbud Display.

Exhibit Review: Monday, July 31st, in the Dome Building. 4-H Cloverbuds are encouraged to sign up for an interview to talk with a judge about what they learned throughout the year. Interviews will be scheduled online, links will be available on the premium book page of the website.

Departure: Exhibits must remain intact until Monday, August 7th, 2023. All exhibits will be released on Monday, August 7th, 2023 between 4:00p.m and 6p.m. Exhibits must be signed for upon release.



Eligibility: All exhibitors must be enrolled in the Adams County 4-H Cloverbud program. CLOVERBUD 4-H IS STRICTLY NON-COMPETITIVE.

4-H Cloverbud Exhibits may consist of the following areas:

Needlework projects:

- Cloth
- Clothing
- Embroidery
- Sewing
- Weaving
- Macramé
- Fabric decoration
- Knitting and Crocheting

Arts and Crafts projects:

- Painting and sketching including watercolors, finger paints, chalk, pencil, pen, crayon on weed, metal, paper, canvas and various kinds of folk painting.
- Sculpting – any article constructed from wood, clay, paper mache, wax, metal, etc.
- Jewelry
- Doll craft and puppets
- Decoupage
- Woodworking – drawing on wood, building toys, etc.
- Holiday and seasonal decorations
- Creative do-it-yourself articles made from scrap of anything items made from a kit

Sports and Recreation projects:

- Homemade sports equipment such as games, jump ropes, bows and arrows, etc.
- Evidence of sports and recreation activity such as posters, pictures, photos, etc.

Nature and Environment projects:

- Pine cones
- Pressed leaves and flowers
- Dried flower or weed
- Homemade bird feeders
- Pictures or poster about nature
- Insects
- Anything done on wood other than decoupage (with dried flowers, leaves, etc.)

- Poster or pictures about science

Personal Development projects:

- Scrapbook or poster of accomplishments

- Any poster about food or food prepared by the 4-H Cloverbud member that DOES NOT REQUIRE REFRIGERATION or a scrapbook about nutrition.

Self-Determined projects:

- Any project completed by 4-H Cloverbud member that does not fit into the other categories.
