RULES:

(also see Livestock, Equine & Small Animal Rules)

1. Read 4-H General Rules
2. Read 4-H Livestock, Equine & Small Animal Rules
3. Exhibitors are allowed to enter a maximum of two (2) animals in this department; (2) animals may be entered but only (1) per class. The Animal used in Showmanship will be considered the members 'high point' animal.
4. Classes and age groups will be assigned by the Superintendent depending on the number of entries.
5. The judge will determine and enforce show rules.
6. Llama/Alpaca's need not be in full fleece to show. They may be shorn.
7. In order for members to be eligible for the High Point awards they must participate in all classes (showmanship, obstacle, costume and public relations). The combined best score from these classes will be awarded high point. The Animals used in showmanship will be considered the 'high point' animal.

Record Book:

Members complete Livestock E-Record and any necessary supplements. Due the Friday before Labor Day



Camelid Project members who intend to exhibit their animal(s) at the Adams County Fair must complete the following to remain eligible for fair entry and exhibition:

1. Enroll in the Llama/Alpaca Project by enrollment deadline.
2. Complete and file an Animal Care and Housing Form (Primary Care) on 4HOnline (leased animals and animals not housed at home must turn form into Extension Office)
3. ID all animals in 4HOnline by June 1 deadline.
4. Attend Animal Record Book Interviews and present an up-to-date E-Record Book.
5. Enter fair classes online by entry deadline.
6. Complete and turn in E-Record Book the Friday before Labor Day to the Extension Office. *If a record book is not completed for each species exhibited, the member will forfeit premiums/awards and be ineligible to exhibit that species at the next year's Fair.*

Costume: Entrants are required to actively participate in the construction of a costume for themselves and their alpaca entry. Judging will be based on originality and complexity of costume, ability of handler and alpaca to show as a team (does alpaca handle challenges of the costume, such as dangling parts, legging, etc).
