RULES:

(also see Livestock, Equine & Small Animal Rules)

1. Read 4-H General Rules
2. Read 4-H Livestock, Equine & Small Animal Rules
3. Exhibitor must furnish cages and padlock (if needed) for display.
4. Entries will be judged on basis of quality and appearance of the animal, its habitat and overall knowledge of the project.
5. Exhibitors must be on hand to show their animals during judging.
6. Interview judging is required of all exhibitors on day of judging. Those not interviewed are not allowed to exhibit their animals for judging.
7. Sharing of project animals is not permitted.

Record Book:

Members complete Companion Animal E-Record and any necessary supplements. Due the Friday before Labor Day



Open Class: Open Mini's (Age 5-7) Pocket Pet Class - See Department Open Minis - Saturday, July 22nd 10:00am



Pocket Pet Project members who intend to exhibit their animal(s) at the Adams County Fair must complete the following to remain eligible for fair entry and exhibition:

1. Enroll in the Pocket Pets Project by the enrollment deadline.
2. Complete and turn in an Animal Care & Housing Form (Primary Care) in 4HOnline
3. ID all animals in 4HOnline by June 1 deadline (project animal must be owned by ID deadline).
4. Attend Animals Record Book Interviews and present an up-to-date E-Record Book.
5. Enter fair classes online by deadline
6. Complete and turn in the Companion Animal E-Record the Friday before Labor Day to the Extension Office
If a record book is not completed for each species exhibited, the member will forfeit premiums/awards and be ineligible to exhibit that species at the next year's Fair.
