POULTRY CAGES

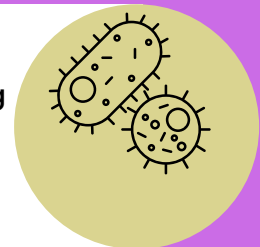
No cage request required. Cages will be set up for judging of breeds and exhibitors will be directed which cages to place their birds upon arrival. Transportation cages are the responsibility of the exhibitor.



MANDATORY HPAI MEETING

Each poultry member MUST attend a mandatory virtual meeting regarding protocol required to show and associated risks of HPAI (2 offered, family must attend one)

Dates: July 12th or 20th -7:00pm Virtual (see 4-H Calendar for link)



SIGN UP FOR ARRIVAL/VET CHECK TIMES

All members and animals must sign up for arrival time and all animals must pass vet check upon arrival. The scheduling of arrival times should allow shorter wait times and smoother unloading processes.

Exhibitors are eligible to sell ONE eligible animal from any & all market departments in the Adams County Fair Junior Livestock Sale. The eligible market animal they wish to sell at the Jr. Livestock Sale must be declared online by 2pm, Friday Aug. 4th.
