Open Bucket Calf Showmanship



- Pre-entry for all bucket calves is required.
- Everyone must have a signed waiver on file prior to participating in the show
- Calves must be born between April 1 and June 1, of the current fair vear.
- Exhibitor will be allowed to show only one calf.
- Bucket calf judging will be on child's ability to handle
- All calves must be on the bucket, bottle, or weaned at fair time (no nurse cows!)
- All calves must be halter broken.
- Calves may be of any breed or sex.
- All calves will be released immediately after the show.
- Fair rules and regulations on stalls, care of livestock, and health are to be adhered to.
- Bucket calves must go through a vet check on either Tuesday July 29th 4:00-7:00PM
- Winner will receive ribbons only.
