### DIVISION: OPEN BUCKET CALF

- Open Bucket Calf Showmanship



- Pre-entry for all bucket calves is required.
- Calves must be born between April 1 and June 1, of the current fair year.
- Exhibitor will be allowed to show only one calf.
- Bucket calf judging will be on child's ability to handle the calf.
- All calves must be on the bucket, bottle, or weaned at fair time (no nurse cows!)
- All calves must be halter broken.
- Calves may be of any breed or sex.
- All calves will be released immediately after the show.
- Fair rules and regulations on stalls, care of livestock, and health are to be adhered to.
- Bucket calves must go through a vet check (see 4-H Beef for times)
- Winner will receive ribbons only.

- Open Mini Goat Costume Showmanship



- Exhibitor must show an animal already entered by a traditional 4-H member in either the market or breeding classes.
- An adult or traditional 4-H member may accompany the mini exhibitor during the show.
- Mini dress-up show encourages minis to dress up themselves and their goats if they wish.

### DIVISION: OPEN MINI HORSE

- Open Mini Lead Line Class



- Everyone must pre-enter to participate.
- Each participant must have an adult accompany him or her while in the show ring. A lead shank is optional.
- All horses must be vet checked. Horses will be available for participants use. If participant wants to bring their own horse, the horse must go through vet check, see 4-H Horse for times. In lieu of attending the scheduled health checks, a health certification issued within 7 days of arrival must be presented to the show office.
- Helmets are REQUIRED.
