Project Requirements

Market Swine Project members who intend to exhibit their animals at the Adams County Fair must complete the following to remain eligible for fair entry and exhibition:

1. Enroll in the Market Swine Project by enrollment deadline.
2. Attend and complete the Meat Quality Assurance Certification (MQA) annually.
3. Complete and file an Animal Care and Housing Form (Primary Care) on 4HOnline (leased animals and animals not housed at home must turn form in to Extension Office).
4. Properly tag all market swine by tagging deadline.
5. ID all swine in 4Honline by **May 1** deadline
6. Attend Livestock Record Book Interviews and present an up-to-date E-Record Book.
7. Enter fair classes online by entry deadline.
8. Complete and turn in E-Record Book the Friday before Labor Day to the Extension Office.

Project Tips - Market Swine

Additional Information - Animal Entry in 4hOnline

1. 4-H members are required to enter their animals in the 4hOnline enrollment system. This page will help summarize the information required in this system.
2. All swine project animals must be entered in the 4hOnline system no later than May 1st of the current project year.
3. All 'bold' items are required in 4hOnline. 3 images are required for each swine;
1. Tag & Ear Notch Image 2. Left Side Image 3. Right Side Image.
4. It is highly recommended that any and all animals with the potential of attending Fair have ID in 4hOnline, if an animal does not have ID, it will not be allowed at Fair.

Steps for Success:

1. Sign up for 4-H Fourcast Newsletters
2. Attend club meetings & meet your club's swine leader & other swine members
3. Order the swine project manual through your Club Leader to help you learn
4. Download the Livestock E-Recordbook
5. Review Fair premium book to understand show rules and classes
6. Attend required and optional club and county workshops to learn
7. Work on Livestock E-Recordbooks regularly.
8. When in doubt, contact the 4-H office with questions
