Project Requirements

Cat Project members who intend to exhibit their animal(s) at the Adams County Fair must complete the following:

- Enroll in the Cat Project in 4-HOnline
- Complete and submit an <u>Animal Care and Housing Form</u> to the 4-H office by May 1
- Vaccinate your cats
 - Rabies
 - Feline viral rhinotracheitis (FVR)
 - Feline calicivirus (C)
 - Feline panleukopenia (P)
 - Highly recommended: Feline Leukemia (FeLV)
- Identify all cats in 4-HOnline by May 1
 - Required in 4-HOnline:
 - Animal Name
 - Birth date
 - Color and markings
 - Uploads:
 - Photo of rabies tag or proof of rabies vaccination from the office of a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine. Must include date administered and expiration date.
 - Photo of proof of FVRCP vaccinations from the office of a Doctor of Veterinary Medicine. Must include date administered and expiration date
 - *** If your cats' vaccinations expire before the Adams County Fair Cat Show, you will be asked to submit updated vaccination records
 - Optional in 4-HOnline:
 - Photos of cats
 - Sex
 - Breed
 - Weight
 - For a how-to guide to animal ID in 4-H Online, click Cat on the <u>state 4-H</u> Online page, tab: Family Resources
- Keep record of your cat project in the Companion Animal Record Book available for download on the <u>Colorado 4-H website</u>
- Present an up-to-date Companion Animal Record Book (also called e-record) with a green record book cover (buy here) at Record Book Interviews
- Enter fair classes on the Fair Entry website by July 1
- Complete and turn in the Companion Animal Record Book with a green cover by Friday before Labor Day to the Extension Office.
