Project Requirements

Cavy Project members who intend to exhibit their animal(s) at the Adams County Fair must complete the following:

- Enroll in the Cavy Project in 4-HOnline
- Complete and submit an <u>Animal Care and Housing Form</u> to the 4-H office by June 1
- Identify all cavies in 4-HOnline by June 1
 - Required in 4-HOnline:
 - Animal Name
 - o Date acquired
 - Breed = "Other," Enter "Cavy" on next line
 - Sex
 - Optional in 4-HOnline:
 - Photo
 - Weight
 - For a how-to guide to animal ID in 4-H Online, click Small Pet on the <u>state 4-H Online page</u>, tab: Family Resources
- Production Cavies only: get your cavies tagged at our county clinic or elsewhere
- Keep record of your cavy project in the Companion Animal Record Book available for download on the <u>Colorado 4-H website</u>
- Present an up-to-date Companion Animal Record Book (also called e-record) with a green record book cover (buy here) at Record Book Interviews
- ✓ Enter fair classes on the Fair Entry website by July 1
- Complete and turn in the Companion Animal Record Book with a green cover by Friday before Labor Day to the Extension Office.
