## **Project Requirements**

Pocket Pet Project members who intend to exhibit their animal(s) at the Adams County Fair must complete the following:

- Enroll in the Pocket Project in 4-HOnline
- Complete and submit an <u>Animal Care and Housing Form</u> to the 4-H office by June 1
- ldentify all pocket pets in 4-HOnline by June 1
  - Required in 4-HOnline:
    - Animal Name
    - Breed/animal type
    - Date acquired
    - Color and markings
    - Photo
  - For a how-to guide to animal ID in 4-H Online, click Small Pet on the <u>state 4-H Online page</u>, tab: Family Resources
- Keep record of your pocket pet project in the Companion Animal Record Book available for download on the <u>Colorado 4-H website</u>
- Present an up-to-date Companion Animal Record Book (also called e-record) with a green record book cover (buy <u>here</u>) at Record Book Interviews
- 🕑 Enter fair classes on the Fair Entry website by July 1
- Complete and turn in the Companion Animal Record Book with a green cover by Friday before Labor Day to the Extension Office.
