- 5 practice requirement
  - Do we need to change it because of all the cancellations? Leave it at 5.
- 2021 Colorado State 4-H Shooting Sports Championships
  - Alternate format similar to last year
  - Registration via 4HOnline opens July 1st and closes August 6th
  - For counties planning to make use of their Orion Scoring System: A required meeting will be scheduled sometime in June for individuals operating the system
  - Registration fees = \$20 per registered participant
    - No class fees
  - Counties will be responsible for procuring their own targets
  - Hunter safety card upload requirements will be waived
  - Counties are to coordinate with a Colorado 4-H Certified Shooting Sports leader that is from another county to verify state contest target and scorecard submittals
    - Must be a currently approved and enrolled 4-H Volunteer but does not have to be certified in the discipline for which they are observing

- Please have this person sign off on your county submittals by including a simple signed and dated note including their contact information stating that they verify the state contest submittals for your county with your mailed package of targets and scorecards.
    - County may enter up to 6 individuals per class except shotgun which is a maximum of 5 individuals.
    - Discipline Info:
      - .22 Rifle, .22 Pistol, Air Rifle, Air Pistol, Muzzleloader: No course of fire changes from rule book
  - If necessary, a standard clay shotgun target suspended 24" off the ground may be used in place of a muzzleloader gong and must be placed at the required distance listed in the rule book
    - Archery: No 3-D targets are to be included in the contest. Modified FITA courses of fire will be followed as listed in the rule book.
  - Seniors will shoot the Modified FITA course of fire twice, for a total of 40 shots. Juniors will shoot 5 arrows per distance for a total of 20 shots.
  - Updated printable Senior and Junior FITA scorecards will be posted to the State 4-H website soon)
  - Senior archery tie breakers will be followed according to the state contest rule book with the second round of FITA replacing the 3-D score for seniors. Junior archery ties will be broken following the rule book. If a tie still remains, then highest scores per distance beginning at 40 yards then 30,20,10 will be used to break the tie.
    - Shotgun
  - No Sporting Clays will be included in the contest.
  - The Skeet class will consist of 3 rounds of 25 targets shot in sequence for a total of 75 targets. (Label cards round 1, 2, 3)
  - The Trap class will consist of 3 rounds of 25 targets shot in sequence for a total of 75 targets. (Label cards round 1, 2, 3) ● The Orion Scoring System will be used to break all ties up to 74 hits. If a competitor hits 75 targets straight they are to shoot another full round of 25 targets while keeping score on a printable Orion score card. If the competitor does not miss, repeat the process until the competitor misses a target during a complete 25 target round. (These extra round cards will be labeled rounds 4,5,6, etc. as needed and submitted with their state contest score cards)
  - Combined scores for trap and skeet will be used to determine 2021 national qualifiers.
    - Printable score cards for use in the Colorado State 4-H Shooting Sports Championships Alternate Format will be posted on the State 4-H Website when they become available
