

Shooting Sports Premier Exhibitor Selection Criteria 2022

General

- If a member wants to apply for Premier Exhibitor, they must do so via the Fair Entry system by the mid-July deadline
- Essays are to be read and graded by an unbiased individual (not a Shooting Sports volunteer, Shooting Sports parent, or Shooting Sports 4-H Agent)
- Final scores will be released to youth

Fair Project	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Points are given for placings according to points system to right 	Blue - 7 Red - 5 White - 3 Champion - 5 Reserve Champion - 2 Grand Champion - 5 Reserve Grand Champion - 2 Best Records - 5
Practices*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Members are only eligible for Premier Exhibitor if they have met the 5 practice requirement - Points accrue every 3 practices in a single discipline after the initial 5 - Member accrues practice points regardless of discipline submitted for fair exhibit 	5 points/3 practices
Leadership	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Member must submit an essay answering age-appropriate prompts. Deadline = first Friday of July 	Member essay = 20 points
Multiple Disciplines - used as a tie-breaker	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Each additional discipline is worth 1 point - 5 practices in each of the additional disciplines is required 	1 point/additional discipline** only to be awarded if tie must be broken If tie persists, 1 point/additional class

*Practices must be county-approved. Attending and shooting at other counties' practices qualify.

**Disciplines: Air pistol, Air rifle, .22 Pistol, .22 Rifle, Archery, Hunting and Outdoor Skills, Western Heritage, Muzzleloading, Shotgun. Number of disciplines/classes that the member participates in is determined by their county shoot registration.
