## It's Easy to Contribute!

We offer three convenient options for supporting our livestock auction

### Purchase and take possession of the animal for consumption

Animals may be purchased for the buyer's own personal consumption. Consider using it for employee incentives, a fund raising activity, a picnic or club barbecue. If you can't afford or can't use an entire animal, go in with one or more partners. Beef can easily be divided between several buyers. Gather friends and family and fill your freezer with local, home-grown, quality meat! (Buyer is responsible for butcher cost)

### Purchase but do not take possession of an animal in the auction (Buyback)

The buyer bids on an animal and upon the successful bid, the buyer pays the difference between the bid price and the established market price. The animal is then sold to a packer at the market price.

### Additional Contributions (Add-On)

Add-Ons are easy and a great way to increase the total sale price for a youth. The add-on amount is directly credited to the total sale amount for the youth you choose and no bidding is necessary to participate.
